**Through the investments of individuals, foundations, and corporations,  
the Menokin Foundation was able to do the following in 2009:**

---

- Completed excavation of fallen elements at the west exterior of the house and in the interior southwest quadrant.
  - Developed a relational database that documents the original and current conditions of Menokin’s major framing timbers and also pinpoints those artifacts to their original locations in the house.
  - Further developed the long-term vision for Menokin through creation of three-dimensional renderings of the glass concept (more on this concept is found at: [www.menokin.org](http://www.menokin.org)).
  - Held a workshop for 20 area history teachers through Rappahannock Community College called “History Live Here.”
  - Hosted 250 elementary age school students on several field trips.
  - Created a Woodland Trail Guide that takes visitors through the wildlife refuge. The guide is also available on the Menokin web site.
  - Conducted research on Menokin’s enslaved population.
  - Hosted the sixth annual Menokin Music Festival; and
  - And welcomed approximately 2,000 visitors to Menokin over the year.

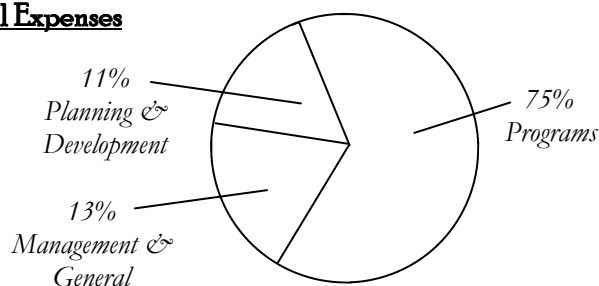

Dear Friends of Menokin,

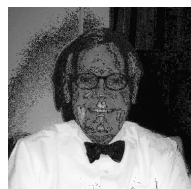
